Millahue, Chile

Every inch of this new luxury retreat is "a feast for the eyes," said *Travel + Leisure*.

Opened last fall as a companion property to Alexander and Carrie Vik's equally stunning concrete-and-glass winery, Viña Vik arranges 22 artist-designed rooms under a swirling titanium roof so that each room's floor-to-ceiling windows provide 180-degree views of the lush hills of Chilean wine country. Guests can enjoy horseback rides through that landscape, and because Vik and other Colchagua Valley wineries are now turning out some great vintages, oenophiles "will find plenty to keep them happily occupied."
